Scholarship Biography

- AAUW- Mabel Parks Scholarship:** Female student in her Junior or Senior year with high academic achievement and demonstrated potential for leadership.
- Ed Aalberts Memorial:** Sophomore, Junior or Senior with a minimum GPA of 3.2 (Preference given to a transfer student from a 2-year Minnesota campus).
- Chet Anderson Leadership Scholarship:** New or continuing students who have demonstrated strong leadership skills in their school and/or community and qualify for an athletic scholarship from BSU.
- Minnesota Energy Resources Scholarship:** A student who received a scholarship during their first year, but is continuing without scholarship support. To be eligible, the student must have a GPA of 3.25 or higher and verifiable financial need.
- Fred Breen:** Bemidji High School graduates who have satisfactorily completed at least 6 semester credits of college course work. The recipients must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5.
- Ray Breen Math Scholarship:** Awarded to incoming students who have excelled in Mathematics. Students must have a minimum ACT composite score of 28 with a minimum Math sub-score of 30. Once awarded, the selected students are required to successfully complete a math course at the level of calculus or above and maintain a 3.25 GPA at full-time status to receive the award for second semester. If the selected students do not register for calculus or a higher level Math course, the scholarship will be withdrawn.
- Annie M. Czarnecki Scholarship:** New entering Freshmen with verifiable financial need.
- Les Duly Scholarship:** Sophomore, Junior or Senior United States citizen of color with preference given to female students with a GPA in the range of 2.5 to 3.25.
- Naylor Electric Scholarship Scholarship:** New incoming Freshmen in the top 15% of their graduating class, or a new transfer student with a cumulative GPA of 3.25.
- Foundation General Scholarship:** New, current, or transfer students are eligible to apply.
- John Glas Memorial Scholarship:** Junior or Senior Minnesota resident with a GPA of 3.0 or higher. Preference will be given to Business Administration majors and athletes, and verifiable financial need.
- Russell and Gudrun Harding Scholarship:** Sophomore, Junior or Senior with a GPA of 2.5 or higher and verifiable financial need.
- James and Janet Love Scholarship:** Sophomore, Junior or Senior with a GPA of 3.0 or higher and verifiable financial need.
- Kathryn, Fred & Mabel Hamm Scholarship:** New or returning students exhibiting leadership, a demonstrated commitment to learn, a strong interest in securing a college education, a high level of reading and writing competence and verifiable financial need.
- James and Marilyn Heltzer Scholarship:** New Freshman attending Bemidji State who graduated from Bemidji High School with a minimum GPA of 3.0 and has a declared major in Professional Education.
- Hartz Scholarship:** New entering Freshmen who will graduate in the top 20% of their class.
- Francis J. Johnson Scholarship:** New or continuing student with verifiable financial need and high academic standing.
- Winston & Irene Naylor Scholarship:** Sophomore, Junior or Senior with verifiable financial need and whose GPA is at least 3.0.
- Special Situation Scholarships:** New or returning student who is at least 25 years old and has a GPA of 2.5 or higher. Preference is given to students who are single parents.
- Chet and Naomi Swedmark Family Scholarship:** Bemidji High School graduates who are currently attending or entering BSU with verifiable financial need.
- George and Sandy Thelen Leadership Scholarship:** Incoming BSU student with demonstrated strong leadership skills, resident of Minnesota with preference given to students from Park Rapids and secondary preference given to students from Northern Minnesota.
- Tuorila/Haiby Scholarships:** Junior or Senior from Minnesota, with verifiable financial need, minimum GPA of 2.5. Preference is given to veterans or the spouse, child or grandchild of a veteran.
