Series Notes

- ▶ Bemidji State falls to 1-10-1 in 12 all-time meetings with North Dakota in a series dating to Feb. 6, 1970.
- ▶ BSU has lost each of its last two games against North Dakota and is winless in each of its last 11 dating back to Feb. 7, 1970.
- ▶ BSU falls to 0-3-0 against North Dakota in Bemidji.

BSU Head Coach Tom Serratore

- ▶ Falls to 78-63-18 (.547) in 159 games at Bemidji State.
- ▶ Falls to 0-3-1 in four career games coached against North Dakota.

Team Notes

- ▶ With an announced attendance of 2,413, Bemidji State played before the largest home-ice crowd of its Division I era (since 1999).
...Tonight marked BSU's first sellout crowd since Oct. 14, 2000 against Minnesota, and just its second sellout since making the move to Division I for the 1999-2000 season.
- ▶ Bemidji State saw its all-time record fall to 881-403-71 (.676) in 1,355 intercollegiate games and its 50th season of competition.
- ▶ BSU saw its all-time Division I-era record fall to 95-109-23 (.469) in 227 games and its seventh season at the Division I level.
- ▶ Tonight's loss snapped BSU's school-record four-game winning streak against Western Collegiate Hockey Association opponents.
- ▶ BSU is winless (0-2-1) in its last three contests, marking the team's first three-game winless streak since Jan. 22-29, 2005 (0-2-1).
- ▶ All five of BSU's losses this season have come in the Friday game of a weekend series, and BSU has dropped its last four consecutive series openers.
- ▶ BSU and UND combined for three goals, the fewest combined goals in a game in the history of the series.
...prev: 4 goals in a 3-1 UND victory on Jan. 29, 2005
- ▶ BSU held UND to a series-low two goals.
...prev: 3 goals on three previous occasions.
- ▶ BSU has scored a total of two goals in its last 149:59 of game time in its series with North Dakota (0.80 GAA for UND).
- ▶ BSU has scored first in each of its last seven games against WCHA foes.
- ▶ BSU out-shot North Dakota, 35-30. Since 1999...
...BSU out-shot UND for the first time in eight meetings. UND had out-shot BSU 273-158 over the previous seven meetings between the teams, out-shooting BSU by an average of 16.4 shots per contest.
...BSU's 35 shots are its most in a game against UND.
...UND's 30 shots are tied for its fewest in a game against BSU.
- ▶ North Dakota committed 13 penalties for 26 minutes in the contest; the 13 penalties are second-most by a BSU opponent this season (15, Minnesota State on 10/14/2005).
- ▶ BSU went 1-for-10 on the power play tonight...
...BSU's 10 power-play opportunities tied for fourth-most in a single game in its Division I era and fell one shy of its Division I-era record (11).
...UND's nine penalties killed (BSU 1-for-10) tied for third-most by a BSU opponent in its Division I era.
