Bemidji State (15-11-3 / 9-5-1 CHA) 5, Robert Morris (9-16-3 / 5-8-2 CHA) 2

Series Notes

- ▶ Bemidji State improves to 6-1-0 in seven all-time meetings with Robert Morris...
 - ...BSU avoids its first back-to-back losses to the Colonials.
 - ...BSU improves to 3-0-0 against Robert Morris in Bemidji.
 - ...tied series high with five goals scored; previously in a 5-1 victory in Bemidji on Jan. 14, 2005, the first meeting in the series.
 - ...RMU's two goals give it six in three all-time games in Bemidji (2.0 goals per game); RMU has scored just three goals in four games against Bemidji State at Moon Township (0.75 goals per game).
- ▶ RMU has scored four goals in its last two games against Bemidji State after scoring a total of five goals in its first five games against the Beavers.

BSU Head Coach Tom Serratore

- ▶ Serratore sees his career record improve to 84-69-20 in 173 games.
- ▶ Sees his record at BSU improve to 84-69-20 in 173 games.
- ▶ Moves to 59-25-10 in 94 regular-season games against CHA foes.
- ▶ Improves his head-to-head record against Robert Morris to 6-1-0.

Team Notes

- ▶ Bemidji State sees its all-time record improve to 887-409-73 (.675) in 1,369 intercollegiate games and its 50th season of competition.
- ▶ BSU saw its all-time Division I-era record move to 101-115-25 (.471) in 241 games and its seventh season at the Division I level.
- ▶ BSU improved to...
 - ...8-0-0 this season; 52-2-1 in its Division I era when scoring five or more goals...
 - ...13-0-2 this season; 84-6-9 in its Division I era when leading after two periods.
- ▶ Bemidji State scored the game's first goal at 1:07 of the first period.
 - ...BSU has scored first in each of its last three games; in seven of its last nine games; 13 times in its last 23 games and 17 times overall this season.
 - ...fastest BSU goal to open a game since **Ryan Huddy** scored at 1:01 of the first period in an 8-1 win over Niagara on Dec. 3, 2005.
 - ...BSU improves to 14-2-2 this year when scoring first.
- ▶ BSU led 2-0 at the end of the first period...
 - ...BSU had scored a total of two first-period goals in its previous six all-time games against Robert Morris.
 - ...BSU had gone four consecutive games against Robert Morris without scoring a first-period goal; last came at 0:15 of the first in an eventual 4-3 overtime victory in Bemidji on Jan. 15, 2005.
- ▶ BSU scored three goals in the second period and led 5-0 at the second intermission...
 - ...7th time this season BSU has scored three or more goals in a period.
 - ...most goals scored through two periods this season, most since also leading Air Force 5-0 after two in the second round of the 2005 CHA Tournament on March 12, 2005.
 - ...biggest second-period lead ever against Robert Morris.
- ▶ BSU scored two goals in the first period and three goals in the second...
 - ...has scored multiple goals in six of its last nine regulation periods of play dating back to the first period at Western Michigan on Feb. 10.
- ▶ BSU extended its Division I-era record streak of consecutive games with a goal scored to 62 dating back to Nov. 6, 2004. The previous record was a 60-game scoring streak from Dec. 13, 2002 to Oct. 23, 2004.
 - ...BSU has scored at least one goal in 122 of its last 123 games played.

 - ...Logan Bittle's five-on-three power-play goal for the Colonials at 8:57 of the third period snapped Climie's personal shutout streak against Robert Morris at 120:22... RMU had not scored against Climie since 8:49 of the third period on Feb. 11, 2005.
