## Beavers hit the road for NSIC action

### Soccer Notebook

• The Beavers split last weekend dropping an overtime game, 1-0, to then No. 5 Minnesota State on Saturday and then beating Southwest Minnesota State 4-0 on Sunday.

• Bemidji State will hit the road twice this weekend making quick stops in Crookston on Friday and Moorhead on Sunday. BSU already traveled once to Crookston for a nonconference matchup against the Golden Eagles. That game saw the Beavers win 5-1.

• **Samantha Ross** (Jr. Stillwater, Minn.) (2-0) is encroaching on a team record set by former goalkeeper Kari Torgerson in 2004. Ross hasn't allowed a goal in the last 425:33 minutes that she has been in net. The record is set at 429:03. She won her second game of the season on Tuesday when she started against Minnesota, Crookston. She made three saves in the win. On Friday she played the second half of the game recorded two more saves.

• **Ashlee Ellefsen** (Jr., Hugo, Minn.) scored two goals in the Sunday game against Southwest Minnesota State. Those four points now bring her career total up to 60, which makes her just 12 points shy of breaking the school record.

• **Brianna Duff** (So., Ramsey, Minn.) notched an assist in Sunday's game which brings her season points total to 16 (6G, 4A). The 16 points is good for second place in the NSIC.

• **Bri Scanlan** (So., East Grand Forks, Minn.) scored a goal in the 4-0 win over Southwest Minnesota State. It was her third goal of the year and her fourth career goal.

• **Rachel Gustafson** (So., Ham Lake, Minn.) rifled a shot into the upper corner from 18 yards out on Sunday to score her second career goal.

• **Abby Kjonaas** (So. Fargo, N.D.) (2-1) picked up her second win of the season as she started against Jamestown on Friday where. On Tuesday she played the second half against Minnesota, Crookston making five saves.

## Head Coach Jim Stone



On July 23, 2002, Bemidji State University took an integral step toward developing a competitive women's soccer program with the hiring of Jim Stone as head coach. The BSU soccer program had never won more than the four

victories Stone's squad achieved in 2002.

Stone has the highest win percentage in BSU history (.480), along with the most wins (51). He is the only coach in BSU soccer history with a record higher than .500 in conference play (.509).

The 2005 season was a record-breaking year for the Beavers. As a team BSU set or tied numerous records, including most wins (12) and most shutouts (10) in a season. The Beavers were also the 12th most improved team in the nation that year.

Under Stone's guidance BSU has been well represented on the NSIC All-Conference teams and garnered its first ever All-American in 2005. Juniors Ashlee Ellefsen (Hugo, Minn.) and Alysha Domiano (Dayton, Minn.) both garnered post-season honors during their freshman campaigns, with Ellefsen being named to the All-NSIC Second Team and Domiano earning All-NSIC Honorable Mention honors. Ellefsen was then named All-NSIC Third Team, Daktronics First-Team All-Region, and Daktronics All-America Honorable Mention in her sophomore year.

Domiano (2008 third team), Megan Wallner (2007 third team), Erin Foss (2005 second team) and Cristina Egnell (2004 third team, 2005 first team) have all been named to CoSIDA Academic All-District squads under Stone's tutelage.

## Scouting Minnesota, Crookston (2-5-1, 0-2-0 NSIC)

- The Golden Eagles are currently on a three-game losing skid, after dropping both games this past weekend losing to Winona State, 3-0, and Upper Iowa, 5-0. Over the weekend Minnesota, Crookston was outshot 41-11.
- The matchup will be the second of the season between the two teams. Bemidji State traveled to Crookston earlier in September beating the Golden Eagles 5-1. The lone goal of that game for Minnesota, Crookston came off of a penalty kick. That game has also been the only home match so far for the Golden Eagles.
- Bemidji State has won the past nine straight meetings between the two teams.
- Minnesota, Crookston keeper Anna Ogaard made 11 saves against BSU in the previous matchup while backup keeper Carmen Sanchez made two saves.
- The Golden Eagles are led by senior forward Justine Jones who has three goals so far this year.

## Scouting MSU-Moorhead (4-2-1, 1-1-0 NSIC)

- The MSU-Moorhead split this past weekend against Winona State and Upper Iowa.
- Jordyn Wallenborn scored the lone goal over the weekend to lift the Dragons past Upper Iowa 1-0 on Saturday. MSU-Moorhead then lost 2-0 to Winona State on Sunday.
- Bemidji State has won seven out of the past nine meetings between the two teams.
- Wallenborn is the team leader in scoring for the Dragons, netting four goals for eight points in the past seven games.
- Keeper Alison Wanner has played every single minute for the Dragons in net so far this season, totaling 26 saves and a 1.51 goals against average.
