### 1. How to disable printing of a quiz

#### Using the Properties tab:

With these settings, the students will not be able to print the quiz while taking it. In addition, they will not be able to send or receive pages.

## 2b. Using the Submission Views tab:

With these settings, the student will see the questions, his/her responses, and the correct answers, **after completing** the quiz.

## 2c. Using the Submission Views tab:

With these settings, even with the right-clicking disabled, the students will see the list of questions, **after completing** the quiz. **They will be able to print the list of questions.**

This is probably not very useful feedback because the students would not know the answers to the questions they answered incorrectly.
