Bemidji State University Department of Residential Life Residents Smoke Free Survey 2003

Nick Zika has completed the results of the smoke free survey of 592 residents in 2003.. To summarize:

- * 592 residents completed the survey
- * 82% of respondents indicated they prefer to live on a smoke-free floor
- * 75% of respondents indicated they prefer to live in a smoke-free hall
- * 72% indicated BSU should add more smoke-free floors
- * 52% indicated all residence halls at BSU should be smoke-free
- * When asked which halls should include more smoke free floors, the results were fairly evenly spread out:

Birch (14%), Linden (15%), Maple (18%), Oak (20%), Pine (14%, Tamarack (18%)

Based on this survey, I am recommending we change the following floors to smoke free designation for the 2004-2005 academic year:

Birch: 2A (current) 3A (current) - do not add additional floors

Linden: Currently no smoke-free floors. Add 1A, 2A, 1B and 3B as smoke-free Maple: 1A & 2A (current) 1B & 2B (current). Add 3A and 3B as smoke-free

Oak: 1C, 2C, 3C & 4C (current). Add 1A and 1B as smoke free

Pine: Currently no smoke-free floors. Add 1st and 2nd floors as smoke-free.

Tamarack: 4, 5, 10 & 11 (current). Add 6 & 7 as smoke free.

This would bring our total smoke-free floors to 26.
