The BSUSA Student Senate would like to see Bemidji State University become a smoke-free campus by Fall of 2011. Over the school year, Student Senate researched smoking bans on other campuses and gathered data through a student survey. With the information gathered and understanding the well-documented risks of smoking and exposure to second-hand smoke, it is clear that students here at BSU support the idea of a smoking ban. With hundreds of colleges across the country already implementing similar policies, there is an overwhelming amount of support for on-campus tobacco restrictions. Over the next year, Student Senate would like to see 1) initially, a 30-foot No Smoking Rule near building entrances, 2) moving to, only designated smoking areas on campus, and 3) finally, implementing a smoke-free policy where no smoking would be allowed on campus.
