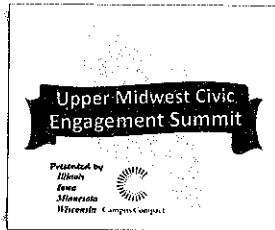


1. Interested in hosting the 2015 Upper Midwest Civic Engagement Summit?
