HEALTH CONTENT & BOT LICENSURE STANDARDS REVIEW

PLEASE use the **HEALTH LICENSURE CHECKLIST** for currently licensed teachers as a guide.

Send/fax applicable unofficial transcripts to Shannon Norman at snorman@bemidjistate.edu or fax to 218.755.3898 for INITIAL evaluation. **OFFICIAL transcripts are REQUIRED on file for licensure.** Request official transcripts from institutions where courses may apply to health content. Send to Shannon Norman, Department of Human Performance, Sport, & Health #29, 1500 Birchmont Dr. NE, Bemidji, MN 56601.

The process to obtain a health license may change at any time to comply with current MN Board of Teaching requirements.
MN Board of Teaching (BOT) licensure mandates: Teachers with a standard teaching license, who complete Health Content courses to add a health license (5-12), must meet **Reading Standards & student teach 4 consecutive weeks in health.** Minimum 2.5 GPA in BSU courses required to student teach. Student teaching cannot be waived.
