# **Professional Education Admission and Completion Requirements**

\*Please use this document in combination with the appropriate Course Schedule\*

#### **Admission to Professional Education:**

- 1. Complete the <u>online application</u> for admission to Education (found on the Professional Education website) and upload required documentation, including:
  - o Transcript(s) evidencing a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher
  - o Transcripts(s) showing completion of 30 semester credits (by the end of current semester)
  - o Letter of recommendation addressing the Education admission rubric
  - Responses to the four (4) required writing prompts
- 2. You will not be allowed to register for ED courses until you have been admitted to the Education program.
- 3. Entry requirements are subject to change. Please see the Professional Education website for current entry requirements.

### **Field Experience Requirements:**

- Professional Education (ED) courses with field experience require additional time outside of class.
- You must meet deadlines set forth by the Clinical Experiences Office (e.g.: placement survey, liability insurance, etc.).
- You must have documented field experience in each level (Elementary, Middle School, and High School) and each Content Area of your license.

## **Testing Requirements:**

- To qualify for a full, 5-year teaching license (Tier 4), candidates must have passing scores on the MTLE NES Basic Skills exams (or equivalent) and three years of teaching experience in Minnesota.
- BSU can only recommend you for a Tier 2 or 3 license once you have official scores on file for the required MTLE Pedagogy and Content exams.
- Candidates should take the MTLE Pedagogy Subtests 1 and 2 after successful completion of ED 3350 Pedagogy.
- Candidates should take the MTLE Content Subtests 1 and 2 after completion of all required Content and Methods coursework.
- See the Professional Education Department's Teacher Licensure Test Guide for additional testing information.
- Minnesota's licensure requirements are complex. Please meet with the Advising Coordinator, Dr. Aspen Easterling to ensure completion of all licensure requirements. To schedule a meeting, e-mail: Teaching.License@bemidjistate.edu

## **Graduation Requirements:**

- Bemidji State University requires completion of 120 credits to earn a bachelor's degree.
- Speak with your advisor to ensure you will meet the minimum credit requirement. You may need to add an endorsement, minor, or certificate.
- If you are double majoring, you will need 150 credits to earn two bachelor's degrees.
- Complete BSU's Application for Graduation while you are enrolled in ED 3350 Pedagogy: Planning for Instruction.
