WHY BEMIDJI STATE

MAJORS: BSU complements popular majors such as Nursing, Education, Biology, Criminal Justice, Accounting and Business with an array of programs that are rarely found elsewhere. These include Wildlife Biology & Aquatic Biology, Exhibit Design, Sport Management, Engineering Technology, Criminalistics, and Indigenous Sustainability. (See next page for majors list)

AFFORDABLE: BSU prides itself on offering a quality education at a low cost. Tuition is just \$3,929 per semester for students taking 12-18 credits (fees are extra), and all students pay in-state tuition regardless of where they call home. Approximately 85% of students receive financial aid.

GREAT LOCATION: BSU is set on a stunning Minnesota lakeshore in the heart of Bemidji, named "Best Minnesota Town" by Minnesota Monthly magazine. This friendly community has a thriving downtown, vibrant culture, lively nightlife, and abundant shopping.

LEARN MORE-EARN MORE: BSU graduates with a bachelor's degree will earn an average of \$17,000 more annually than those with an associate's degree. That's more than \$680,000 during a 40-year career.

WE ACCEPT YOUR CREDITS: BSU accepts collegiate level credits from an array of institutions (see transfer policy). A formal transfer evaluation will be completed within two weeks of admission.

SCHOLARSHIPS: BSU will distribute nearly \$2.4 million in scholarships this year to help students pay for college. Transfer students from a Minnesota community college who meet the required criteria receive a \$1,000 scholarship. Apply for scholarships at www.bemidjistate. edu/go/scholarships

GRADUATE IN AS LITTLE AS 2 YEARS: BSU

has numerous transfer agreements and is participating in the Minnesota State Transfer Pathways program. This allows many transfer students to graduate in as little as two years.

SCHOLARSHIPS

MINNESOTA STATE COMMUNITY COLLEGE TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIP ►

Students who transfer directly from a Minnesota

State system college or tribal college with an Associate of Arts degree or a completed Minnesota Transfer Curriculum (MnTC) with a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher are automatically eligible to receive this \$1,000 scholarship.

Students must be admitted prior to **June 1**.

MEAL PLAN SCHOLARSHIP

Students living on campus their first year are eligible for this scholarship. With an award of two semesters of free meals, the Meal Plan Scholarship provides an excellent opportunity for students to express how and why they would benefit from this award. Submissions vary from creative essays to artistic projects and are accepted until **June 1.** Priority is given to incoming students with a GPA of 3.0 or higher.



AMERICAN INDIAN SCHOLARSHIP BIOGRAPHY ▶


