**Estimated Expenses for a Single International Student
in the English Language Center (ELC), Undergraduate or Graduate Programs**

2020--2021 Academic Year
(two terms from August to May)

Fall Term 2020: Class starts on Monday, August 24th
Spring Term 2021: Class starts on Monday, January 11th

In-State Tuition for All International Students

In-State Tuition & Fees **\$9,208/academic year or \$4,604/term**

Undergraduate international students including ELC students on an F-1 or J-1 visa must take a minimum of **12** credits each term (fall and spring) to maintain their visa status. A minimum of **9** credits each term is required of graduate students. Summer term is optional; however, if you take summer classes, there will be additional expenses for tuition and books. Average BSU courses are three credits, and undergraduate students may take up to 18 credits each term without additional tuition cost. Some individual classes may have course fees, which varies from term to term.

Room & Meals (on campus) **\$8,920** academic year (double occupancy room with meal plans)

Health Insurance **\$1,720** (estimated for 12 months)

Miscellaneous Expenses **\$1,850** (estimated books, supplies and personal expenses)

Estimated (I-20) Total **\$21,698 (Your Financial Affidavit must show a minimum of this amount)**

The above figures are meant to serve as guidelines and are subject to change. In order to obtain a student visa, you must prove that you will be supported fully for your entire course of study.

Health insurance is required of international students. The estimated health insurance rate for 2012-21 calendar year is \$1,720, and you must plan on this expense.

Limited on-campus employment opportunities are available, and an international student must be registered full time to be eligible to apply after arrival on campus. For off-campus opportunities through Curricular Practical Training and Optional Practical Training, see an advisor in the International Program Center. Please be aware that there are strict restrictions on international student employment in the U.S.

All international applications are processed on a rolling basis. Your application for admission and supporting credentials should be submitted as early as possible to allow us sufficient time to process your application and for you to obtain your visa and arrange for travel to the U.S.

All new international students are required to arrive in Bemidji one week before each term starts to participate in the mandatory new international student orientation. The BSU International Program Center conducts the orientation every spring and fall terms.
