- Applications will be reviewed by the Teaching and Learning Center, with the applications and recommendations forwarded to the President's Office. The awards are determined by the President's Office.
- Applications are due May 12, 2020. Awardees will be notified by May 29, 2020.
- Research presentations will be a 20-minute ZOOM format. (The Teaching and Learning Center will provide technical support in developing the presentation.)
- This application is asking for your commitment to present at the August 19, 2020 BSU Today! Please be aware that information is constantly being shared globally on this emerging field.
- We encourage applications from all academic and service areas of the university.
