


How to Opt In to Receive Text Messages from BSU

Students need to opt in to receive text messages from BSU departments regarding dates and deadlines as it pertains to registration, financial aid, and billing.

To begin -


Have your cell phone with you and then log into your e-Services and follow these steps:

1) Click on 'Account Management'.







Your college or university will use this service to send you text messages about campus events including deadlines and reminders. **This service may or may not be used for emergency notification.** To receive emergency notifications, search for "emergency alert" on your college or university website.
2. To stop text messaging, select "Turn off" text messaging on this website or contact your college or university.
3. If you have any questions or need help call 1-877-GO MNSCU or 1-877-466-6728.
4. This is a free service provided by Minnesota State Colleges and Universities. However, message and data rates from your mobile carrier may apply.
5. The frequency of text messages will vary by college or university.
6. The delivery of text messages depends upon external mobile carriers. Minnesota State Colleges and Universities cannot guarantee message delivery.
