If you are attending multiple sessions, you will need to register for all your summer term courses prior to the awarding of aid. Summer aid disbursement will begin on May 28, 2021, **unless your classes have not started**. If this is the case, the earliest your aid can be disbursed is 10 days before the first class begins. You must be enrolled at least half-time (6 undergraduate or 5 graduate credits) to be eligible for a federal or state loan. Students admitted to a Master's Degree program, Graduate Certificate or Graduate Teaching Licensure program need a minimum of 5 graduate credits. Undergraduate teacher licensure students need a minimum of 6 undergraduate credits.

**CAUTION:** Contact the Financial Aid Office immediately if you are dropping courses prior to the start date of the course, if some of your classes are cancelled after your aid is processed, or if you plan to withdraw from a summer course. This will result in a recalculation of your eligibility. If the recalculation results in an over award, you will become ineligible for aid you have already received. An over award will require your immediate return of loan, grant and all other aid for which you were determined to be ineligible and disallowing future federal and state aid until the over award is paid in full.
