The deadline to do this is before October 31 of each year. This does not apply to the 120-day certification requirement. NOTE: Listings on both websites are subject to change from year to year. To meet the Agreement to Serve requirement: Your school must be listed on the Department of Education's website at the time you begin teaching, and; Your Teacher Education Program must have been designated as high-need on the Department of Education's website when you received your TEACH Grant. I understand that each year I receive a TEACH grant; I must complete TEACH Grant counseling and sign the Agreement to Serve (ATS) located at, https://studentaid.gov/app/launchTeach.action, complete the BSU TEACH Grant application, and maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.25 each semester. I understand that if I fail to complete the 4-year teaching obligation within 8 years of completing or ceasing my program of study, my grant will convert to an unsubsidized loan which will have to be repaid with interest accrued from the date the grant funds were first disbursed.
