NOTE: Federal and State Grants end after a student earns a 4-year baccalaureate degree.

*A student with a 4-year degree from an institution may not receive Federal loan if enrolled in a second major <u>within the same</u> <u>degree</u> at that institution. Students receive only one BA, BS, MA or MS degree at an institution and often confuse receiving a second major with receiving a second "degree." The Federal government allows only certain exceptions to this rule. They are indicated on the reverse side. <u>A student who earned a baccalaureate degree at one institution, however, is eligible to apply for a</u> <u>Federal loan at a second degree granting institution.</u>
