<sup>\*</sup>A student with a 4-year degree from an institution may not receive Federal loan if enrolled in a second major within the same degree at that institution. Students receive only one BA, BS, MA or MS degree at an institution and often confuse receiving a second major with receiving a second "degree." The Federal government allows only certain exceptions to this rule. They are indicated on the reverse side. A student who earned a baccalaureate degree at one institution, however, is eligible to apply for a Federal loan at a second degree granting institution.
