Loan Program Guide for Students Who Have a 4-year Degree

NOTE: Federal and State Grants end after a student earns a 4-year baccalaureate degree.

*A student with a 4-year degree from an institution may not receive Federal loan if enrolled in a second major within the same degree at that institution. Students receive only one BA, BS, MA or MS degree at an institution and often confuse receiving a second major with receiving a second “degree.” The Federal government allows only certain exceptions to this rule. They are indicated on the reverse side. A student who earned a baccalaureate degree at one institution, however, is eligible to apply for a Federal loan at a second degree granting institution.

A student who mixes graduate and undergraduate credits may find the credits which do not apply toward the degree ineligible for funding. Example: If you are enrolled in a Master’s degree program, credits for determining loan eligibility may not include undergraduate credits.

A student completing credits for teacher preparation (to apply for licensure but not obtaining a degree/certificate from BSU) will have undergraduate loan eligibility only (even if credits are taken at the graduate level) and be subject to undergraduate aggregate borrowing limits.
