## Bemidji State University Student Billing Guide Fall 2021

Registration cancellation for non-payment is a process by which the University reviews all outstanding accounts to ensure minimum financial requirements have been met. The first cancellation for nonpayment is August 20<sup>th</sup>.

- Student will not be dropped from their registered classes if they meet one of the criteria.
  - 1. Financial Aid has received your FAFSA either for summer term or previous academic year.
  - 2. A payment of 15% or \$300 on fees and tuition, whichever is less.
  - **3. Scholarship or Third Party Students:** scholarships or benefits are approved and on record with the Business Office
  - 4. Set up a Nelnet Payment Plan through eservices
- **All student bills** must be paid in full September 27, 2021.
