<u>SINGLE ITEM:</u> Web site redesign due to the MBA online degree Cohort development Mr. Scott Faust:

BSU must have a great website but the website is currently dated. We have needed to update the website. Therefore we are going to do a complete overhaul of the whole BSU website. Right now the MBA is on the leading edge of the whole website. We sent out RFPs in October and received 16 proposals by November 4th. White Whale, out of Oakland, California was a midpriced competitor that will allow BSU to administer the website.

BSU will pay \$208,000 for entire site not just content. White Whale creates websites exclusively for education; mostly in higher education. They are pursuing an aggressive time table. The website must be done in 1 year. White Whale has done work for MIT and NYU. Individuals in BSU's IT department liked what they have seen of White Whale; however, the contract has not been completed.

By February 6th

White Whale will complete research phase and phone meetings, and finalize campus visit.

March 21st

Meetings with dean and VPs, unions, sep with students, packed to cover in 2 days Must hear from stakeholders

April 11

Complete design, with 3 alternative designs, templates, and admissions content – April 11 – MBA

Beginning of May
