## **Policy Statement**

Bemidji State University Non-degree Seeking and Visiting Students Policy states that individuals/students notcurrently admitted to a Minnesota State Colleges and Universities institution may enroll at Bemidji State University (BSU) for a purpose other than seeking a degree. This admission status is termed "Non-degree Seeking Student Status." Individuals admitted as non-degree seeking students are not eligible for financial aid or to participate in intercollegiate athletics. A student who is enrolled at another Minnesota State institution may enroll as a "Visiting Student" at Bemidji State University. A visiting student may enroll in up to 18 credits at Bemidji State University. Total number of credits in a semester of enrolled credits at all system colleges and universities cannot exceed 22.

## **Scope and Purpose of Policy**

The scope of this policy applies to all students seeking entrance for admission to the university who fall into one of the two following categories, non-degree seeking or visiting as defined in policy statement. The purpose of the policy is to allow for admission those students who are not seeking a degree from the university but are seeking to benefit from the courses and curriculum available.

#### Rationale

The rationale for this policy is to provide non-degree seeking students who are not seeking a degree and visiting students a means of enrolling at Bemidji State University.

#### **Definitions**

Non-degree seeking student is a student who is not working toward a degree. A special student must meet the same academic progress requirements as a regular student. Undergraduate non-degree seeking students are encouraged to apply for regular student status if they plan to pursue a degree program. Non-degree seeking students do not qualify for financial aid and are not eligible to participate in intercollegiate athletics.

<u>Visiting student</u> is defined as one who is enrolled at another Minnesota State institution(s) and is seeking to take courses available at the university.

## **Procedures**

Visiting students must meet the following provisions in order to enroll with the visiting student status.

- 1. Visiting students shall satisfy Bemidji State University course prerequisites.
- 2. Enrollment is restricted to students who have earned 24 Minnesota Transfer Curriculum credits with at least a 2.0 cumulative grade point average and at least a 67% completion rate at a system college or university.
- 3. Enrollment as a visiting student is denied to any student who has an enrollment hold due to conduct or satisfactory academic progress reasons at any system college or university.
- 4. Enrollment as a visiting student is denied to any student who has an enrollment hold due to outstanding financial obligations at any other system college or university.
- 5. The registration window for visiting students is the same as that for non-degree students. Typically, the initial date of this registration window is the day after the lastscheduled date for current freshman.
- 6. Bemidji State University will limit enrollment of visiting students in courses that historically have enrollment requests exceeding available seats.

Students who are denied enrollment as a visiting student may submit an application for admission (non-degree seeking or undergraduate degree-seeking). Students with financial holds will not be accepted.
