Conduct the following assessments: Phonemic awareness assessment with one student. Running record (fluency) with one student. Observe a guided reading lesson Bring a diverse/inclusive picture book with you each week. Read aloud a picture book at least once, but whenever possible. 			
Number of Hours Required for Licensure	Wednesdays all day 20 Hours Minimum required for licensure. We have created a field experience that provides extra time to support the development of your teaching practice.			
Expectations of Teacher	 Allow teacher candidate to read aloud to your class, administer literacy assessments, and observe a guided reading lesson Please mentor your student and be willing to share information about the literacy resources and assessments used in your classroom.
