Read aloud a diverse picture book at least once, but whenever possible.</li> <li>Conduct a reading conference with a student who needs additional reading supports.</li> <li>Conduct a reading observation of your classroom teacher.</li> <li>(Recommended but not required) Teach your writing lesson plan.</li> <li>Arrive ready to help your classroom teacher.</li> <li>If you have questions about any FE assignment, email Dr. O'Connell ahead of time.</li> </ul>			
Number of Hours Required for Licensure	Wednesdays and Fridays all day. 20 Hours (minimum) required for licensure. We have created a field experience that provides extra time to support the development of your teaching practice.			
Expectations of Teacher  Course Instructor(s)	<ul> <li>Allow the teacher candidate to read aloud to your class, conduct a reading conference, and observe your instruction.</li> <li>Please mentor the teacher candidate and be willing to share information about the literacy resources, routines, procedures, and assessments used in your classroom.</li> <li>Complete a 3-minute online dispositions survey on the teacher candidate(s).
