Complete a "Context for Learning" as described in the edTPA. Enhance a unit plan that will taught during your time in the classroom. Lead 2 whole-group lessons. 2 Journal/Reflections—end of 2nd week, end of exp.
Number of Hours Required for Licensure	Minimum 25 hours—as arranged
Expectations of Teacher	 Welcome student. Show student where they can keep their coat/items. Show them around. Help them feel comfortable in the setting. Allow student to lead 2 whole-class lessons. Facilitate student supporting individual and group learning. Share information about demographics, curriculum, instruction, classroom management, routines, engagement strategies and assessments used in your classroom. Share information about a unit that will be taught in your classroom this semester. Verify completed hours in SL&L. Complete online dispositions survey about the student.
