Candidates should teach and plan four whole class lessons, ensuring<br>that one lesson addresses each content area (science, social studies, math,<br>language arts). Candidates are expected to do a daily journal/weekly reflection,<br>a book study of "The First Days of School," mentor teacher interview, and an<br>assessment, analysis and reflection of a student. The BSU candidate must notify<br>the cooperating teacher and faculty members of any late arrivals or early<br>departures, as well any absences due to illness. |  |  |  |
| Number of Hours<br>Required                         | Candidates are expected to attend field experience three days (Tuesday through<br>Thursday) during school operating hours.
