Help them feel comfortable in the setting.</li> <li>Allow student to lead 2 whole-class lessons.</li> <li>Facilitate student supporting individual and small group learning.</li> <li>Share information about demographics, curriculum, instruction, classroom management, routines, engagement strategies and assessments used in your classroom.</li> <li>Share information about a unit that will be taught in your classroom this semester.</li> <li>Verify completed hours in SL&amp;L.</li> <li>Complete online dispositions survey about the student. (The link will be emailed at the end of the semester. Sample on next page.)</li> </ul>
