

## K–12 and 5–12 Education Course Sequence

**All licensure candidates must follow this sequence to complete their Education (ED) coursework.**  
Content coursework in specific majors is taken prior to and concurrently with Standards of Effective Practice (SEP) coursework.

**The following courses can be completed prior to applying for admission to the Teacher Education program:**

- Content specific coursework without the ED prefix (i.e.: SCI, MATH, GEOG, ENGL, PHED, MUS, etc.)

- Have a 2.5 GPA or higher  
- Have completed 30 semester credits  
- Recommendation Form  
- B- or above in college-level writing course **or** address 4 writing prompts

**Field Experience Requirements:**  
Talk with your advisor about field experience requirements in your Content Area courses. You must have documented field experience in each level of your license (Elementary, Middle School, and High School).

**Eligibility for Student Teaching:**  
You must complete all major coursework (with a C- or higher) and all Core Curriculum requirements before student teaching.
