Expectations of Student	The Bemidji State student (teacher candidate) is encouraged to be an active classroom participant and take on opportunities to support the social studies teacher and students. Candidate may conduct observations, work with individual students, work with small groups, co-teach, and assist with planning, curriculum delivery, and assessment. The candidate is required to teach two lessons (expected 40-60 minutes in length); they may utilize the cooperating teacher's curriculum or create their own lesson materials (depends on the cooperating teachers wishes). The central aim is to gain experience facilitating learning and being in front of the classroom. Overall the main objective communicated to students is to "help, not hinder" the work of the cooperating teacher. We hope our students are responsive and willing to take on several activities to support the demanding work of the classroom.
