Expectations of BSU Student	 Identify and apply developmentally appropriate practices. Complete a developmental profile on a child by observing the child 3 different times and creating narratives of the observations. Actively engage with students and the classroom teacher, support individual and small-group learning in the classroom. Facilitate 3 small group activities. Observe interactions in the classroom, room layout, daily schedules and procedures. These will be discussed in class. 			
Number of Hours Required	16-hour minimum 4 visits of 4 hours every other week. (Or as arranged.)			
Expectations of Host Teacher	 Welcome student. Show student where they can keep their coat/items. Show them around. Help them feel comfortable in the setting. Share information about program operations (such as curriculum decisions, parent communications, observation and assessment, lesson planning, guidance, building relationships with children, etc). Share information about the children in your class, child development, and your use of developmentally appropriate practices. Model best practices for working with preschoolers. Work with student to coordinate time for observing. They need to do at least 3 20-minute observations of a child. (Only one observation per visit.) Provide opportunity and direction for student to deliver 3 developmentally appropriate small group activities sometime during their experience (ideally 1 at each of their last 3 visits.) Verify completed hours in SL&L. Complete online dispositions survey about the student. (The link will be emailed at the end of the semester.)
