Expectations of Student	 Per PELSB, all FE Hours must be documented in SL & L and approved by the host teacher prior to receiving a grade in this course. Help your host teacher with this process as needed. The teacher candidate will be in the assigned field experience classroom full days on Wednesdays [unless an alternative schedule is needed due to course conflicts]. [The teacher candidate must meet with course instructor for approval]. Be engaged in the classroom. Do not sit in the back of the room and watch. Interview the host teacher to better understand teacher thought process. Take initiative and ask the host teacher for tasks, such as assisting teacher in daily teaching duties [read alouds, running small group stations, walking students to other classes, etc.]. The more active you are in the classroom, the better equipped you will be for teaching. Submit 4 journals to both Ed 3100 & Ed 3110 discussing what you have noticed in terms of differentiation, scaffolding, behavior management, classroom procedures, etc. 			
Number of Hours Required	 Elementary Teacher Candidates will complete full days (Wednesday's) field experience. Any missing days will be made up on Fridays since there are no Ed courses that day. For extenuating circumstances (as approved by the instructor) a minimum of 20 hours must be submitted to pass the course Ed 3100 should be taken in conjunction with Ed 3201 and Ed 3110. 			
Expectations of Teacher	 Mentor your student and be willing to share information about the resources and assessment used in the classroom. Contact Sonia O'Bryan if any concerns arise. Students will have questions. Please mentor the students in response to these questions. Per PELSB, complete a brief host teacher module. Complete a 3 minute online disposition survey on the teacher candidate(s) at the end of the semester in SL & L. A sample of the survey can be found on the next page. Verify field experience hours in SL & L.
