

AFFIDAVIT FOR ARREST WARRANT OR CAPIAS

BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, on this day personally appeared the undersigned affiant who after being duly sworn by me, on their oath stated:

My name is David L. Armstrong, and I am a peace officer employed by the Texas Department of Public Safety, Dallas County, Texas as a Texas Ranger. I am the Affiant of this Affidavit for Arrest.

On September 06, 2018 at about 09:59 P.M., Amber Renee Guyger committed the offense of Manslaughter, a violation of the T.P.C 19:04 a Felony of the 2nd degree against Complainant Botham Shem Jean, when the suspect, Guyger, shot and killed the Complainant during an encounter. The offense occurred at 1210 S Lamar apartment # 1478 in Dallas, Dallas County, Texas.

DALLAS (AP) — The case against a white Dallas police officer who shot and killed a black neighbor will be presented to a grand jury, which could decide on more serious charges than manslaughter, the district attorney said Monday as an affidavit provided a fuller description of the officer's account.


