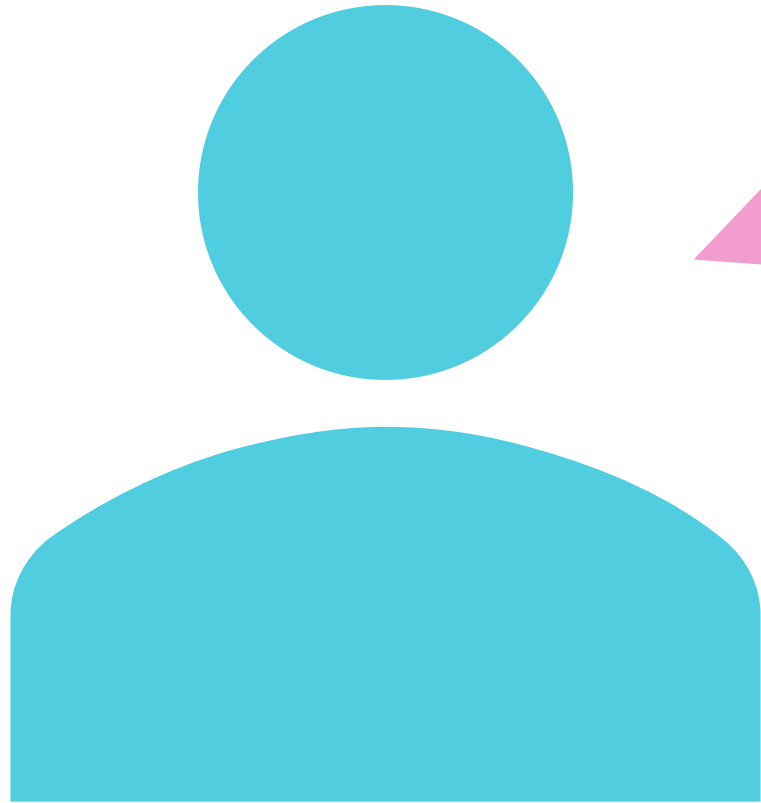

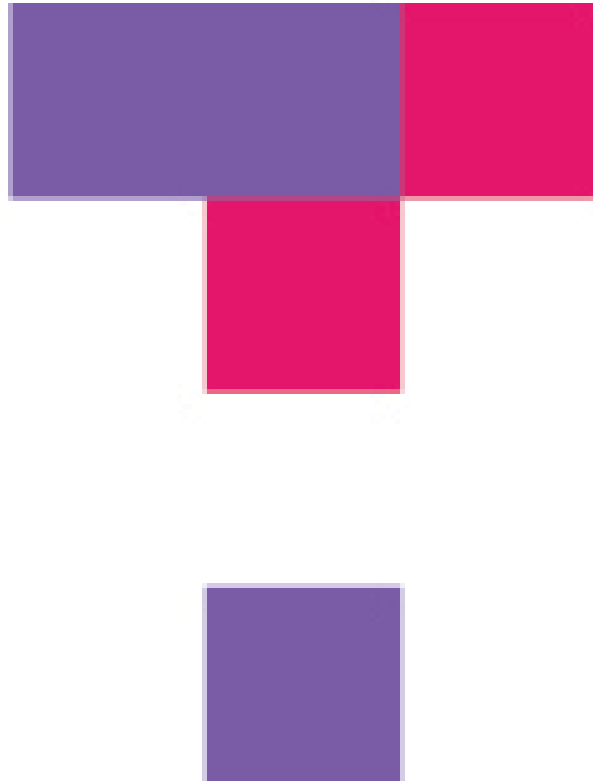

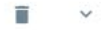

Start slow

Be deliberate

Consider anonymous replies

Engage with the responses

Start **slow**





Be deliberate
about the
**questions and the
language** you use

Give **content notes**
for problematic
content

Consider
anonymous
replies to
encourage
honesty





Point out **common themes**

Address **questions**

Make **connections** with lecture content
