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PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

The Honors Program is an alternative path to complete liberal education courses at BSU. Current students are encouraged to apply!

- Honors Program community members complete Liberal Education Goal Areas 1 – 6.
- To complete their Liberal/Honors education, community members will take the following Honors Program courses in lieu of Liberal Education Goal Areas 7 – 11.
 - ❑ HOPR 1190, Introduction to Honors, 1 credit
 - ❑ HOPR 3700, Honors Seminar, 9 credits [repeatable with different topics]
 - ❑ Either an additional 3 credits of HOPR 3700 OR a 3000-4000 level elective outside of their major
 - ❑ HOPR 3899, Capstone Preparation, 1 credit
 - ❑ HOPR 4899, Capstone Presentation, 1 credit
- Honors Program community members attend at least two Honors Council Lectures and author a short reflection each semester.
- Honors Program community members are encouraged to engage in leadership opportunities and social/community events offered by the Program.
