NEILSON FOUNDATION EMPLOYER APPLICATION SUMMER 2021

The George W. Neilson Foundation is offering partial funding for local employers to hire interns during the summer of 2021. Funding for up to 15 internships, including 14 positions in private/for-profit business, pertaining to any major or program offered by Bemidji State University or Northwest Technical College, and one position in health/nursing.

- 50% of the hourly compensation for the intern will be paid by Neilson Foundation, **up to** \$2,500 per business.
- 50% of the compensation paid by the business.
- Business needs to be within 30 miles of Bemidji city limits.

** Please note, businesses **must be in the for-profit sector**. All Non-Profit organizations are encouraged to apply to the Neilson Foundation directly.*
