EMPLOYMENT AREAS AND PROJECTED DEMAND:

The "Occupational Outlook Handbook" (OOH) reports that economists held about 20,500 jobs in 2019. Government employed 32% of economists, in a wide range of government agencies. Financial advisors held about 263,000 jobs in 2019. 58% were employed by securities, commodity contracts and other financial investments and related activities. 19% are self-employed workers, 13% work in credit intermediation and related activities, 4% work for insurance carriers and related activities and 2% in management of companies and enterprises.

OOH reports the nationwide demand for personal financial advisors is expected to grow 4% (as fast as average) through 2029, with people established in their career generally earning between \$42,950 and \$208,000 per year. The median pay for 2010 was \$87,850 per year.

PLACEMENT INFORMATION FOR ECONOMICS GRADUATES:

Of the 8 Economics graduates from the class of 2018-2019 from Bemidji State University, 100% of graduates reported obtaining related employment within one year of graduation. This does not include students who were not seeking employment, furthering their education, unavailable, or had unknown status.
