### **EMPLOYMENT AREAS AND PROJECTED DEMAND:**

The "Occupational Outlook Handbook" (OOH) reports that economists held about 18,600 jobs in 2020. Government employed 25% of economists, in a wide range of government agencies. Financial advisors held about 275,200 jobs in 2020. 58% were employed by securities, commodity contracts and other financial investments and related activities. 20% are self-employed workers, 13% work in credit intermediation and related activities, 3% work for insurance carriers and related activities and 1% in management of companies and enterprises.

OOH reports the nationwide demand for personal financial advisors is expected to grow 5% (slower than average) through 2030, with people established in their career generally earning between \$44,100 and \$208,000 per year. The median pay for 2020 was \$89,330 per year.

## PLACEMENT INFORMATION FOR ECONOMICS GRADUATES:

Of the 2 Economics graduates from the class of 2019-2020 from Bemidji State University, 100% of graduates reported obtaining related employment within one year of graduation. This does not include students who were not seeking employment, furthering their education, unavailable, or had unknown status.
