## **EMPLOYMENT AREAS AND PROJECTED DEMAND:**

The "Occupational Outlook Handbook" (OOH) reports that cartographers and photogrammetrists held about 13,200 jobs in 2020. Local, state and federal government employed the majority of these workers (41%). The architectural, engineering, and related services industry employed 25% of these workers. Urban and Regional Planners typically need a Master's degree with the vast majority working for local government.

OOH reports that the nationwide demand for cartographers and photogrammetrists is projected to grow 5% (slower than average) through 2030, with people established in their career generally earning between \$42,980 and \$108,890 per year. Cartographer's median income was about \$68,380 in 2020, while surveying and mapping technicians earned an average of \$46,200 per year.

## **PLACEMENT INFORMATION FOR GEOGRAPHY GRADUATES:**

Of the 3 Bemidji State University 2019-2020 Geography B.S. graduates, 2 were still seeking related employment within one year of graduation. The one Bemidji State University 2019-2020 Sustainability and Resource Management B.A.S. graduate went on to continue their education. This does not include students who were not seeking employment, furthering their education, unavailable, or had unknown status.
