# Career Outlook: Health

### **EMPLOYMENT AREAS AND PROJECTED DEMAND:**

The "Occupational Outlook Handbook" (OOH) reports that health educators and community health workers held about 125,200 jobs in 2020. 21% of health educators worked in hospitals; 24% worked in government setting; and 6% worked in religious, grant making, civic, professional, and social assistance settings. 27% of community health workers worked in state and local government and hospitals; 17% of worked in individual and family services; and 12% worked in religious, grant making, civic professional, and similar organizations. OOH reports that the nationwide demand for community health workers is expected to grow 17% (much faster than average) through 2030, with people established in their career generally earning between \$28,010 and \$70,790 per year. The median pay for 2020 was \$42,000 per year. Health educator's nationwide demand is also expected to grow 17% through 2030, with people established in their career generally earning between \$33,720 and \$101,890 per year. The median pay for 2020 was \$56,500 per year.

#### PLACEMENT INFORMATION FOR HEALTH GRADUATES:

Of the 7 Bemidji State University 2019-2020 Health Education B.S. graduates, 100% reported obtaining related employment within one year of graduation. Of the 7 Bemidji State University 2019-2020 Community Health B.S. graduates, 100% reported obtaining related employment within one year of graduation. This does not include students who were not seeking employment, unavailable, or had unknown status.
