EMPLOYMENT AREAS AND PROJECTED DEMAND:

The "Occupational Outlook Handbook" (OOH) reports that the public relations specialists held 272,300 jobs in 2020, while reporters, correspondents, and broadcast news analysts held about 46,700 jobs in 2020.

The OOH reports that the median annual wages for salaried public relations specialists were \$62,810 in 2020. Employment of public relations specialists is projected to grow 11% (faster than average). Employment of reporters, correspondents, and broadcast news analysts is projected to grow 6% (as fast as average) through 2030. Salaries for news analysts, reporters, and correspondents vary widely but the median annual wage is \$49,300. Having an internship or other related experience will provide an advantage when entering the workforce.

PLACEMENT INFORMATION FOR MASS COMMUNICATION GRADUATES:

The competition for jobs for Bemidji State University Mass Communication graduates has increased significantly. Of the 12 Bemidji State University 2019-2020 Mass Communication graduates, 77.8% reported obtaining related employment within one year of graduation. This does not include students who not seeking employment, continuing their education, unavailable, or had unknown status.
