EMPLOYMENT AREAS AND PROJECTED DEMAND:

The "Occupational Outlook Handbook" (OOH) reports that mathematicians and statisticians held about 44,800 jobs in 2020. Mathematicians held about 2,700 jobs. 47% worked in federal government; 17% worked in colleges, universities and professional schools and 26% worked in management, scientific, and technical consulting services. Statisticians held about 42,000 jobs in 2020. 12% worked in federal government; 14% worked in scientific research development services; and 17% worked with insurance carriers and healthcare and social assistance.

OOH reports that the nationwide demand for mathematicians and statisticians is expected to grow 33% (much faster than average) through 2030, with established mathematicians generally earning between \$61,130 and \$170,150 per year. The median pay in 2020 was \$110,860 per year. Statisticians earned a median pay of \$92,270 per year in 2020. Many mathematicians and statisticians have advanced degrees. The median annual wages for high school teachers were \$62,870 in 2020.

PLACEMENT INFORMATION FOR MATHEMATICS GRADUATES:

There are many career opportunities for Bemidji State University Mathematics graduates. Of the 3 Bemidji State University 2019-2020 Mathematics graduates with a B.S., two reported obtaining employment within one year of graduation and one continued their education. Of the 3 Bemidji State University 2019-2020 Mathematics graduates with an Education B.S. 50% reported obtaining related employment within one year of graduation. This does not include students who were not seeking employment, unavailable, or had unknown status.
