EMPLOYMENT AREAS AND PROJECTED DEMAND:

The "Occupational Outlook Handbook" (OOH) reports that medical and clinical laboratory technologists and technicians held about 335,500 jobs in 2020. The majority (47%) of medical laboratory technologists and technicians were employed in hospitals; 20% worked in medical and diagnostic laboratories; 9% worked in offices of physicians; and 5% worked in colleges, universities, and professional schools.

OOH reports that the nationwide demand for medical technologists is expected to grow 11% (faster than average) through 2030, with people established in their career generally earning between \$31,450 and \$83,700 per year with the median pay of \$54,180 in May 2020.

PLACEMENT INFORMATION FOR MEDICAL LABORATORY SCIENCE GRADUATES:

There are many career opportunities for Bemidji State University Medical Laboratory Science graduates. Of the 4 Bemidji State University 2019-2020 Medical Laboratory Science graduates, 100% reported obtaining employment within one year of graduation. This does not include students who were not seeking employment, continuing their education, unavailable, or had unknown status.
