Deadline Bemidji State University seniors who plan to complete a human services-related internship in Greater Minnesota are eligible to apply for this scholarship award of \$1,000. Applicants must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50 in their major and be of senior status, having completed 90 or more credits.
