## Career Outlook: Science Education

#### **EMPLOYMENT AREAS AND PROJECTED DEMAND:**

There are a variety of areas for employment with a science education major, although most become teachers, either at the elementary or secondary level. The "Occupational Outlook Handbook" (OOH) reports that in 2020 there were 598,500 middle school teachers, and 998,800 high school teachers. Employment of teachers is geographically distributed much the same as the population.

OOH reports that the nationwide demand for high school teachers is expected to grow 8% (as fast as average) through 2030, with people established in their career generally earning between \$41,330 and \$102,130 per year. The median pay for 2020 was \$62,870 per year.

#### PLACEMENT INFORMATION FOR SCIENCE EDUCATION GRADUATES:

There are many career opportunities for Bemidji State University Science graduates. Of the 6 BSU 2019-2020 Science Education graduates, 66.7% reported obtaining related employment within one year of graduation. This does not include students who were not seeking employment, furthering their education, unavailable, or had unknown status.
