EMPLOYMENT AREAS AND PROJECTED DEMAND:

The "Occupational Outlook Handbook" (OOH) reports that in 2020 there were 598,500 middle school teachers, and 998,800 high school teachers. Employment of teachers is geographically distributed much the same as the population. The market varies widely by area and subject specialty.

OOH reports that the nationwide demand for high school teachers is expected to grow 8% (as fast as average) through 2030, with people established in their career generally earning between \$41,330 and \$102,130 per year. The median pay for 2020 was \$62,870 per year.

PLACEMENT INFORMATION FOR SOCIAL STUDIES GRADUATES:

There are many career opportunities for Bemidji State University Social Studies graduates. Of the 8 Bemidji State University 2019-2020 Social Studies Education (B.S.) graduate, 80% reported obtaining related employment. This does not include students who were not seeking employment, unavailable, or had unknown status.
