EMPLOYMENT AREAS AND PROJECTED DEMAND:

The "Occupational Outlook Handbook" (OOH) reports that industrial production managers held about 203,800 jobs in 2021. They are employed in all areas of manufacturing, splitting their time between the production line and an office. They typically need several years of related work experience in addition to the degree. Construction managers held about 478,500 jobs nationwide in 2021. The areas that employed the most were specialty trade contractors, nonresidential/residential building construction, and heavy and civil engineering construction.

OOH reports that the nationwide demand for industrial engineering technicians is expected to have slower than average growth through 2031, with people established in their career generally earning between \$37,790 and \$85,530 per year. The median pay for 2021 was \$60,220 per year. Industrial production managers with experience can earn between \$64,150 and \$170,470 with the median pay of \$103,150. The demand for construction managers is expected to grow 8% (faster than average) through 2031 with people established in their career generally earning between \$60,050 and \$163,800 per year and with the median wage of \$98,890.

PLACEMENT INFORMATION FOR PROJECT MANAGEMENT AND APPLIED MANAGEMENT GRADUATES:

There are many career opportunities for Bemidji State University Technology, Art, and Design graduates. The one Bemidji State University 2020-2021 Applied Management B.A.S. graduate, reported obtaining related employment within one year of graduation. Of the 23 Project Management B.S. graduates, 95.2% reported related employment. This does not include students who were not seeking employment, furthering their education, unavailable, or had unknown status.
