**NRSG 3920: Global Health Perspectives in Nursing: China
(2 credit course in Spring & 2 credit course in Summer)**

Course Design & Experiences for Bemidji State Students Going to China

Course Design: Two 2-credit elective nursing courses.

- **Pre-Trip Phase: (2credits) January through April, 2020**
 - Prepare the students for international travel
 - Acquire passport, Visa, immunizations, physical
 - Develop knowledge about international travel etiquette, Chinese culture, traditions, health beliefs, family values, transcultural nursing theory, and team building

- **Travel Abroad Phase: (2 credits) May 11 through 28, 2020**
 - Leave Minneapolis for Jinhua, China May 11th
 - Housed at Jinhua Polytechnic (JPU) campus hotel
 - Partnered with JPU nursing students during time at JPU
 - Participate in nursing skills simulations with JPU nursing students
 - Shadow Chinese nurses/providers at Chinese Western hospital and at traditional Chinese hospital
 - Experience several unique historical and/or culturally significant activities, locations, and foods of the region
 - Attend classes about traditional/holistic treatments
 - Collaboratively present identified health/nursing issue with JPU nursing student partners
 - Leave Jinhua and sight-see culturally-rich locations enroute to Shanghai; Leave for Minneapolis May 28th
