Gender-Inclusive Housing

Linden Hall will have gender-inclusive 2- and 3-person suites. Gender-inclusive suites in Linden are for anyone who wants to live with people with whom they feel comfortable – no matter their gender. Students who elect this option must be open to living with a person of any gender.

Birch Hall has gender inclusive floor bathrooms with private toilet and shower rooms.

Oak Hall has limited single with private bathrooms.

You choose your room and/or roommate/suitemate through the housing application in your BSU e-Services account under the Housing and Dining tab! The housing application allows you to search for potential roommates, form roommate groups, and select your room.





Priority Point FAQ8

Exactly what is the Priority Point Process?

The Priority Point Process is designed to recognize our residence hall students through a chance to select a special room option (for the following academic year) based on their length of time in the residence halls, their involvement in leadership opportunities and their academic success. In addition to special room options, those participating in the Priority Point Process also get priority selection as to the location (hall and floor) of their room.

I won't have many points. Should I still participate in the Priority Point Process?

Single w/ Bath (Single room with private bathroom)

Single in 2- or 3-Person Suite (Single room with

shared bathroom)

Yes! Even though students with the most points will have a better chance of securing a special room option, all students who submit a Priority Point Worksheet improve their odds. In previous years, Housing & Residential Life has been able to accommodate the majority of students who participated in the Priority Point Process.

What are special room options?

Special room options are all rooms other than doubles. They include singles, two- or three-person suites, double-as-singles, and singles with baths.

If I participate in the Priority Point Process and choose a room type where I will be living with others, do I get to pick my roommates, even if they did not participate?

In order to pick roommates, students must form a group in the roommate section of the housing application. We recommend that the group member with the earliest room selection time-slot completes room selection for the entire group. Contact the Housing & Residential Life office with questions.
